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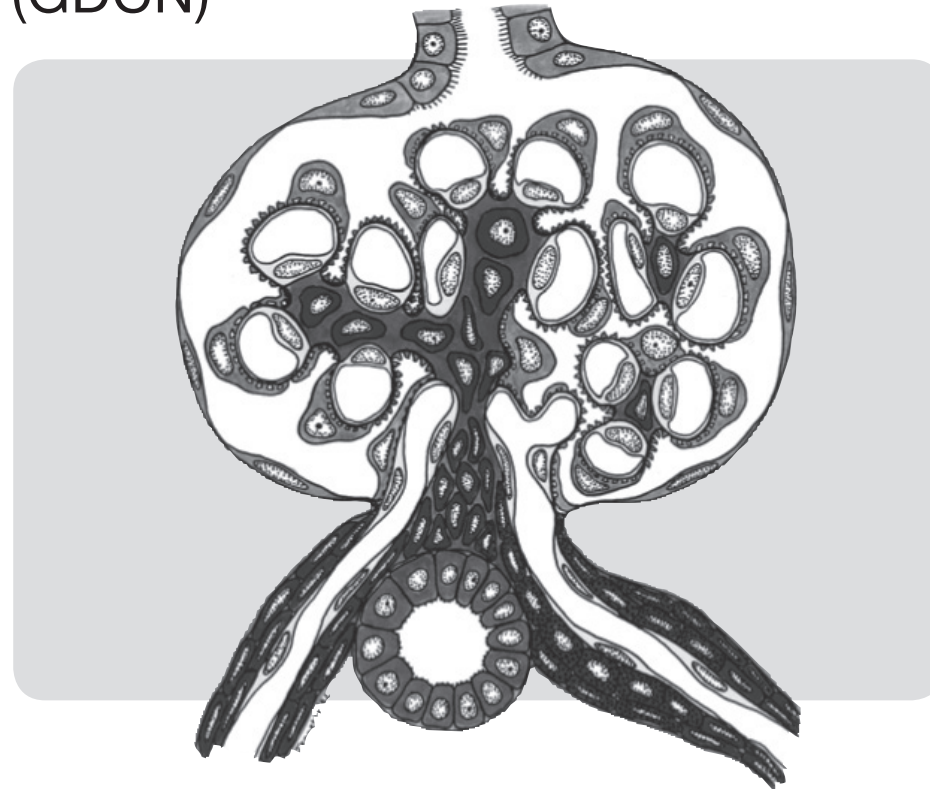

## PURPOSE

Glomerular disease is what is known as an “orphan disease”, a rare disease that affects a small population of patients but has major repercussions. Primary non-inflammatory glomerular diseases cause serious morbidity and mortality and account for 12% of the end-stage renal disease population, costing Medicare more than three billion dollars. This meeting provides an opportunity for nephrologists and renal pathologists to discuss current trends in research/clinical trials and their implementation in private practice.

## TARGET AUDIENCE

Private practice nephrologists and trainees, especially those working in rural communities.

## EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVES

The information presented at this educational activity should improve your ability to:

- Recognize and understand the pathophysiology of various glomerular diseases
- Utilize new treatment protocols/experimental therapies for glomerular disease
- Describe the role that the GDCN patient registry plays in Glomerular disease research
- Discuss treatment and clinical management options with attending colleagues.
