



State Policy Tracking: 2011 Session

Alabama

HJR 157: Chronic Kidney Disease Task Force

Resolution to create a CKD Task Force (there was one created in 2006 as well: PL 2006-502). Goals of task force are to: assess the current & future impact of CKD on residents, examine trends in state CKD population and needs, examine the state's role in long term care, family caregiver support, and assistance to persons with CKD, examine state policy regarding the effective treatment and prevention of chronic kidney disease.

STATUS: Passed house, in senate committee

SB 258: Appropriations FY 2012

This bill makes an appropriation of \$198,000 from the State General Fund to the Alabama Kidney Foundation, Inc., for the support and operations of the Alabama Kidney Foundation, Inc. Program for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2012

STATUS: Passed Senate, in House committee

HB 123: Appropriations FY 2012: Education

This bill appropriates \$291,000 from the Department of Public Health to the Alabama Kidney Foundation for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2012.

STATUS: Sent to Governor for enactment.

HJR 496: Lupus Awareness Month

House joint resolution designating May 2011 as "lupus awareness month" in Alabama.

STATUS: Enrolled, Assigned Act No. 2011-349
