



State Policy Tracking: 2011

Arizona

HB 2605: Transplant/Health Services funding

This bill would allow the use of transaction privilege taxes collected from the repeal of the accounting and reporting expenses tax credit be used to fund organ transplants and other covered health and medical services provided to Arizona Medicaid recipients.

STATUS: Introduced

HB 2606: Transplant Funding

Adds a provision that would allow the health and human services administration to accept private gifts, grants, and donations for nonexperimental transplants for Medicaid recipients.

STATUS: Introduced

HB 2698: Transplant Funding from State Lottery

30% of unclaimed state lottery prize money will be transferred monthly to fund transplants for Medicaid recipients.

STATUS: Introduced

HCR 2039: Transplant Awareness Month

Designates the month of April 2011 as Transplant Awareness Month to promote heightened awareness of the dire needs of Arizonans who are awaiting a lifesaving organ transplant and to encourage each resident of Arizona to donate one dollar to restore funding to Arizona's transplant program to make these transplants possible for our fellow Arizonans.

STATUS: Introduced

SB: 1612: General Appropriations 2011-2012

\$198,000 appropriated for "Renal and nonrenal disease management".

STATUS: Enacted, 4/6/11: Public Law 24
