



State Policy Tracking: 2011-2012 Session

Pennsylvania

HB 100/SB 750: Donate Life PA Act/Uniform Anatomical Gifts Act

Amends existing legislation to include the Uniform Anatomical Gift Act; Donate Life PA Registry established; funding for education/outreach relating to organ & tissue donation; creates organ & tissue advisory committee; ensure that the state education curriculum includes info about organ donation for 9-12th grade students; annual education program for DOT employees; continuing ed credit for health professionals.

STATUS: In Committee

HB 1422: Amending Anatomical Gift Law

Makes several changes to current law, including: verification of pre and post-donor status and ability to change donor status in the Department of Transportation's driver licensing database.

STATUS: In Committee

HB 1589: Expansion of the Organ Donation Advisory Committee

Expands the committee to include one representative of federally qualified health centers and one representative of the Department of Transportation.

STATUS: In Committee

HB 1164: Amending the Organ and Bone Marrow Donor Act

This legislation removes the sunset provision of the Organ and Bone Marrow Donor Act, thereby making the tax credit to employers for granting paid leaves of absence to organ donors available for tax years commencing in 2011 and beyond.

STATUS: Passed House, in Senate committee
